	while school visits are in progress. A sign to this effect will be			
	displayed in the Church and Tithe Barn and reception staff will			
	notify visitors that photography is not permitted. Tithe Barn staff			
	will monitor the use of cameras: anyone seen taking			
	photographs will be reminded not to continue, and if they persist	1	1	2

	Resistance to the above will result in Tithe Barn staff, workshop			
	coordinator and Tithe Barn manager being called and, if			
	necessary, contacting the police. At the same time, the			
	workshop(s) will be suspended and children will be evacuated			
	from the sight of the adult(s) in question.			
	Tithe Barn staff will not take photographs of the workshops			
	unless consent is given in writing by the school.			
7	Equipment has been chosen to minimize risk. Children will be			
	monitored and supervised at all times by Tithe Barn staff and			
	school staff when using equipment. Correct safe use of	1	1	2

	monitored. Persistant inappropriate use will result in child /			
	children being removed from the relevant task.
